Both our School Council and Eco Warriors recently enjoyed a fantastic visit from a representative of the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust. The session was packed with hands-on learning and engaging discussions.

During the visit, pupils explored a range of topics including fossils and native plants, gaining insight into the history and biodiversity of our local environment. They particularly enjoyed examining real fossil samples and learning how different types of plants support local ecosystems.

The volunteer also spoke about several local initiatives and community projects led by the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust, encouraging the children to get involved in helping nature thrive right on their doorstep. This included learning how to create hedgehog highways, as well as simple garden projects designed to welcome birds, insects, and other wildlife.
