Behaviour Policy

Addendum for COVID-19

May 2020

Pupils attending school during a phased return period at Keyingham Primary will be expected to follow the guidance put in place during this time. These rules and procedures are in place to try and keep all children and staff as safe as possible whilst they are in the school building/setting.

- If a child does not follow the safety guidelines in place, and displays behaviour that puts other children, themselves and/or staff at risk, their parents/carers will be contacted and they will be asked to take them home. These behaviours could include for example: not following appropriate sanitary or respiratory hygiene guidance, purposely not adhering to social distancing, leaving their home group or going into other 'out of bounds' areas in/around school and putting other children/staff in situations that could put their health at risk.
- The child will be allowed to return to school once a risk assessment has been completed in partnership with parents/carers.
- If the child returns and continues to display behaviour that goes against the guidelines/risk assessment, they will not be allowed to access provision within the school setting and will therefore continue to access the home-learning provided by staff.
