What will I receive each day?	Every day, your child's teacher will post a photo of your child meeting or working towards their EHCP or academic targets. The comment will be your child's 'voice' e.g. "Today, I worked well in a group with my peers" or "Today, I sounded out and blended my phonics". We hope that this allows you some insight in to their achievements and daily activities and to be able to praise them for their efforts and progress.
Can I add photos etc to my child's journal?	We would love to see what they are achieving outside of school. A two-way communication is helpful for us to better support your child in school and we welcome your photos or comments.
Can I ask questions through Tapestry, if I have them?	If you have any queries, your child's teacher and the SEND team will monitor their journal on a daily basis. If you have a question, please either call the school office or add it through Tapestry and we will call you to resolve it as soon as possible.
