

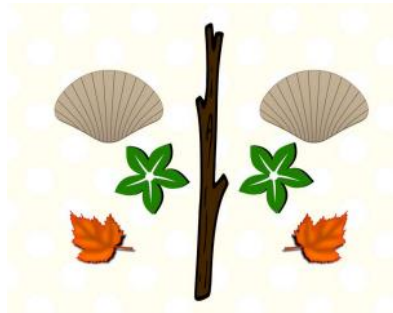
Symmetry BUG

Something is symmetrical when it is the same on both sides. A shape has symmetry if a central dividing line (a mirror line) can be drawn on it, to show that both sides of the shape are exactly the same.

You will need:-

Sticks
Stones
Leaves
Shells
(any other natural resources you can find)

Activity 1



Make a pattern using natural materials with one vertical line of symmetry. You could draw a line or use a stick to show the line of symmetry.

Activity 2



Create an animal with one line of symmetry using the natural resources you can find. You could make a butterfly, bird, spider or an animal's face.
