A ruler or a tape measure (showing cm and mm)

When you have accurately measured your object, calculate the difference between your estimated measurement and the accurate one.

How many things can you measure? Below are some ideas:-

- A tree
- A fence
- Leaves
- Plants/flowers
- Rocks
- Sticks
- You might even be able to measure an insect.
