

## Data Handling



### You will need:-

- Chalk
- Treasures from your garden including:-  
flowers/shells/sticks/rocks/pebbles/leaves/feathers

### Activity:-

- Draw a chart, like the one below, using chalk in your garden and put all of your treasures you have collected inside it.
- What did you find?
- What did you collect the most of? How could we find out?
- Could we estimate? How could we check?
- How can we organise data to make it easier to understand?
- What do we use? Tally charts, bar charts or pictograms.

Here is an example of how your chart should look:-

Complete the 'count' and 'tally' sections. Remember to draw four lines and then cross over for the fifth.. This allows us to count in fives.
