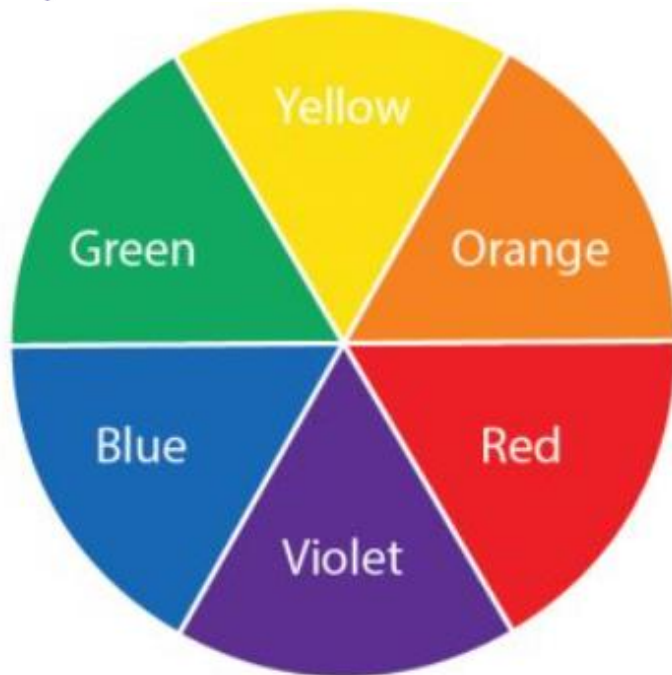
Kandinsky's famous art work



Kandinsky was from Russia. You can see Kandinsky liked to use shape and a mixture of primary and secondary colours in his art work.

His artwork is **abstract**. This means his art work does not represent real life.





### Secondary Colours

Secondary colours are colours made by mixing two primary colours together: yellow, blue and red.

### Challenge
