What is the symbol for Christianity?

There are lots of symbols for Christians but the main ones are The Cross and The Fish.



Fish

Jesus died on the Cross, so the Cross reminds Christians that God loved them so much he sent his only son.

In Greek language, the words Jesus Christ, God's son and Saviour start with the letters, I, C, H, T, H, U, S. When you



put the letters together it spells ICHTHUS, which means 'fish', so some Christians wear the symbol of a fish.
