What is a biography?

A biography is a piece of non-fiction writing all about a person and their life. It is written about them by somebody else. If the person writes it themselves, it is called an autobiography.

A biography includes lots of information about the person's life and their achievements.

Key elements to include in a biography are:

- date and place of birth (and death, if applicable)
- current location of residence.
- educational background.
- professional experience.
- area of expertise.
- major achievements

Who is JK Rowling?

Joanne Rowling was born on 31st July 1965 in Yate, Gloucestershire. As a child, Rowling loved reading and writing fantasy stories which she would share with her younger sister.

She then became a British author, the creator of the popular and critically acclaimed Harry Potter series, about a young sorcerer in training.

After graduating from the University of Exeter in 1986, Rowling began working for Amnesty International in London, where she started to write the Harry Potter adventures. In the early 1990s she travelled to Portugal to teach English as a foreign language, but, after a brief marriage and the birth of her daughter, she returned to the United Kingdom, settling in Edinburgh. Living on public assistance between stints as a French teacher, she continued to write.

The first book in the Harry Potter series Harry Potter and the Philosopher's stone (1997) was released under the name J.K. Rowling, she used J.K as her publisher recommended a gender- neutral pen name. The book was an immediate success, appealing to both children and adults. The book featured vivid descriptions and an imaginative story line. It followed the adventures of the unlikely hero Harry Potter. A lonely orphan who discovered he is actually a wizard and enrols in the Hogwarts school of Witchcraft and Wizardry.

The series of books received numerous awards and and went on to become worldwide famous films loved by all.
