This you will need:

- Toiletries (please note, deodorants must be roll-on, no aerosols).
- Clothes, shoes and underwear. For many activities closed toed shoes, long sleeved t-shirts and trousers are required. (these are required for nearly all sessions, so bring plenty). We recommend wearing old clothes for activity sessions.
- Waterproof clothing (jacket, trousers and wellies).
- Large plastic bag for dirty clothes.
- A bath towel.
- Sun cream and sun hat, if the weather is due to be warm. Gloves, hat and scarf, if the weather is due to be cold.
- Pyjamas and slippers.
- A named water bottle.

Useful items:

- Books, playing cards and other quiet games
- Money for snacks and souvenirs in our shop (no more than £15).
