



Year 2 Autumn 1 Being Me

This first Jigsaw unit of work is all about being me in my world. In this Puzzle (unit) the children discuss their hopes and fears for the year ahead – they talk about feeling worried and recognising when they should ask for help and who to ask. They talk about rights and responsibilities; how to work collaboratively, how to listen to each other and how to make their classroom a safe and fair place. The children talk about choices and the consequences of making different choices, set up their Jigsaw Journals and make the Jigsaw Charter.

Questions for family learning

- What are you looking forward to this year?
- Are you worried about anything that might happen this year?
- Can you tell me some good (positive) choices a person can make in school?
 - How do you show you are a good listener?
 - What do you do to get on with other children?
- If you're worried about something, who can you ask for help in school and at home?
- How does your teacher reward /praise children who make positive/helpful choices?
- What are the Jigsaw Friends in your class called? How are the Jigsaw Friends used in your Jigsaw lessons?
 - Can you tell me about Calm Me time?
