

Year 6 Autumn 2 Celebrating Difference

This second Jigsaw unit of work is all about celebrating difference. In this Puzzle (unit), the class talk about differences and similarities and that for some people, being different is hard. The children talk about bullying and how people can have power over others in a group. They talk about strategies for dealing with this as well as wider bullying issues. The class talk about people with disabilities and look at specific examples of disabled people who have amazing lives and achievements.

Questions for family learning

- What is prejudice and discrimination, can you give an example?
- Why is there an Equality Act in the UK? Who does it protect and why?
- What role does power play in a bullying situation? Who has the power and why?
 - Why do some people choose to bully?
 - Can difference be a source of celebration? Can you give an example?
 - Does having Pause Points during lessons help you concentrate?
- How does being able to do Calm me time help you regulate your emotions?
 - What is a role model? Can you think of some good examples?

Research and write about someone who has overcome their disability to become successful and achieve their goal and dream.
